


CAMINO REAL  
DE  
TIERRA ADENTRO



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In April 1598, an advance group of Spanish soldiers got lost in the desert south of El Paso, looking for the best route to the Rio Grande. A captive Indian named Mompil traced in the sand a map of the only safe passage, which would soon form part of the Camino Real de Tierra Adentro, which was in its historical period the largest land trade route in the world. The path that we propose starts from the border with the US marked by the Rio Grande and the wall that Trump wanted to build to defend its nation from less economically prosperous countries, in the "well-known" Ciudad Juárez. This itinerary, which in some places exactly follows the route of the Camino Real, a monumental 2,560-kilometer-long trade route that ran from the city of Santa Fe to Mexico City, will lead us to discover a wonderful country rich in culture, art, traditions and with a surprising nature. From the view of imposing sand dunes and very deep canyons that remind us that we are guests on this planet, we discover and relate with the dolphins, the most intelligent and sensitive animals on earth, and then we meet the stunning colonial architecture, one of the few positive legacies of Spanish colonialism. Statues and images of the Catholic religion, interpreted with the culture of suffering desired and imposed by Isabel la Católica, coexist with relics of pre-Hispanic tradition in the harmony of a faith that knows no religious distinctions. Finally, the meeting with the great muralist José Clemente Orozco and with the Sistine Chapel of Mexico that he painted to interpret the history of this magical country whose sublime art is certainly not secondary to the art of other countries in the world. Colours, smells, languages remind us of lands that are close and at the same time far from our daily habitat, giving us a splendid childlike sensation of wonder and admiration.




## DAY 1

12:30 pm: lunch on the open air after the visit of las Grutas.



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
01:30 pm: walking city tour: Catedral – Palacio del Gobierno y sus murales - Plaza de Armas – Plaza del Ángel.

05.30 pm: arrival at Barrancas del Cobre and transfer to Hotel Mirador Barrancas.




07:00 pm: cocktail and dinner at the hotel.




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12:30 pm: return to the hotel and lunch.

Mirador de las Estrellas – Mogotabo – Mirador del Cielo – Nido Águilas.


05:30 pm: return to the hotel – cocktail and dinner.

05:30 pm: arrival at Chepe train station of Los Mochis – transfer by minivan to Best Western Hotel.




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## DAY 6

04:00 pm: pick up of travelers and transfer by minivan to Mazatlán.


08:00 pm: arrival in Mazatlán and transfer to hotel DoubleTree by Hilton.

Noon: transfer by boat to Playa de Isla de Piedra and lunch in a palapa.




04:00 pm: pick up of travelers and transfer by minivan to Guadalajara.

08:00 pm: arrival in Guadalajara and transfer to Hotel Morales.




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



## DAY 8




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06:00 pm: return to the hotel.




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## DAY 9

09:30 am: walking visit of the historical centre: Catedral – Teatro Juarez – Universidad Jardin de la Union – Alhondiga de Granaditas.



08:00 pm: return to the hotel




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## DAY 11

10:00 am: arrival in San Miguel de Allende – El Mirador – visit of the historical centre.




